The Board of Governors of the Club held a Board Meeting by telephone earlier today. One of the matters discussed was the scheduled re-opening of the Club on April 1<sup>st</sup>. The dictates of prudence as well as recent government regulations have, of course, made this impossible.

First of all, in response to inquiries from some members, we should let you know that we have seen to it that our staff has not suffered any financial harm as a result of our closing. We will make every effort to continue this policy. Thanks to the careful administration of the Club in the past, we are currently able to do so. However, at the same time, we will be on the lookout for any governmental benefits to which we may be entitled that could assist us through this difficult period.

During today's meeting, we discussed with our Manager, Kevin Cousineau, the possibility of beginning a Food and Beverage Take-Out service for our members. This is an activity permitted in Delaware at this time. The result of this discussion is that the Board has directed Kevin to begin such a service. He has informed us that the Take-Out service can and will begin on Wednesday, April 1<sup>st</sup>. To that end, please find enclosed a flyer detailing the scope of the service and how you may take advantage of what it has to offer.

In passing, we should mention that our kitchen staff is enthusiastic about offering this service to members. If for any reason you have a concern about coming to the Club to pick up food during the COVID-19 outbreak, you should consult guidelines that have recently been published in many media sources, including the internet, as to how to use take-out services in a safe manner. We should say that even prior to COVID-19 the Club had very high sanitary standards and every effort will be made by the Club to minimize person-to-person contact when you come to pick up what you have ordered.

In conclusion, we hope that you look forward to having access to our well-stocked inventory of fine wines and spirits as well as to the superior cuisine of our expert chefs. But, in view of the fast-moving nature of the COVID-19 situation, we will refrain at this time from scheduling a date when the Club will be fully re-opened. But rest assured that we will continue to monitor the situation closely so that we will know when the earliest opportunity to re-open the Clubhouse has arrived without jeopardizing the health of our members and staff. We look forward to that time of reconnecting very much and, in the meantime, we earnestly wish you all good health.
