Dear Fellow Members of the Wilmington Club:

We are pleased to announce that the Club will reopen on Monday, June 1st. Lunch will be served on that date beginning at noon. Although there will be no doubt that you are once again in the warm and familiar precincts of the Club, there will be certain new protocols in effect that are mandated by Phase 1 of the Governor's Reopening Plan. Among these are the following:

1. Social distancing of six feet is to be maintained at all times.
2. Masks will be required in the Clubhouse. You may remove your mask once you are seated at your table.
3. Doors leading into the Clubhouse will be propped open to reduce contact points.
4. Hand sanitizer will be available at all entrances as well as various locations throughout the Clubhouse.
5. The various dining tables have been repositioned throughout the Club to ensure social distancing and to maximize the number of individuals who may be served.
6. A reconfigured Members' Table will remain in the Main Dining Room.
7. Shareable plates offering items such as celery and melba toast will be available upon request only.
8. Reservations will be required.
9. Members may only bring guests that reside in their household.
10. A member wishing to dine with another member, or members, should so indicate when making a reservation so that the required social distancing seating arrangements can be made.

You may also be assured that the Club has not only maintained, but has also strengthened, its already very thorough sanitary procedures throughout the Clubhouse.

We look forward to seeing you back in the Club and we will keep you informed as to the transitions to Phase 2 and Phase 3 as they may apply to us. We hope that these transitions are in the not too distant future.
